

## Scholarship Programme for 2021 entry



### ► Academic Scholarship

- Academic Scholarships are offered for entry to Years 5, 7, 10 and 11.
- Students currently attending Goulburn Valley Grammar School may apply for Years 7 and 11 scholarships.
- Students not currently attending Goulburn Valley Grammar School can apply for scholarships for entry at Years 5, 7, 10 and 11.
- Scholarships at Year 5 are awarded for two years.
- Scholarships at other levels may be awarded for 2 years or the duration of secondary education, providing the student makes satisfactory progress from year to year.
- Academic Scholarships provide for up to 50% remission of the tuition fee. All other fees are payable.
- Scholarships are conducted through the Edutest Testing Programme.
- The closing date for applications for 2021 entry is: 4pm Friday, 13th March, 2020.
- A fee of \$85 (incl. GST) is charged for Academic Scholarship applications.
- A late fee surcharge will be charged for applications received after this date.
- The Scholarship Exam is held at Goulburn Valley Grammar School on Saturday 21st March, 2020. Candidates need to arrive by 8.45 am.

### ► General Excellence Scholarships

- General Excellence Scholarships are offered for entry to the secondary section of the school, for students entering Years 7 to 11.
- Current Goulburn Valley Grammar School Year 6 students may apply.
- Students in Years 6 -11 not currently attending Goulburn Valley Grammar School may apply.
- General Excellence Scholarships provide for up to 50% remission of tuition fees and may be awarded for 2 years or the duration of secondary education. All other fees are payable.
- Awards will be made on the basis of a written application. These applications will be reviewed by a selection panel who will recommend a short list to be interviewed.
- In addition to the written application, short listed applicants may be required to sit a short academic assessment.
- Students will be required to demonstrate strong academic potential, together with a capacity to excel in such areas as service, leadership, music, drama, the arts and sport.
- The closing date for applications for 2021 entry is: Saturday 21st March 2020.
- For students who have lodged an application for an academic scholarship and paid the application fee, no further charge will be made for the General Excellence Scholarship. Students who have not lodged an Academic Scholarship application will be charged a \$85 (incl. GST) fee with the Scholarship application.

### ► Aboriginal and Refugee Scholarships

The GVGS Aboriginal and Refugee Student Scholarships have been established to provide educational opportunities for students who have the potential to lead within the community. These Scholarships will be awarded to an Aboriginal student and a Refugee student for Year 7 entry in 2021.

Applicants are asked to submit written applications which may be followed by an interview with a selection panel chaired by the Principal. A second interview may be required. Application forms are available from the Registrar or from the school website and should be completed and returned to the school by Friday 20th March, 2020.
